One giant oak, ancient beech,

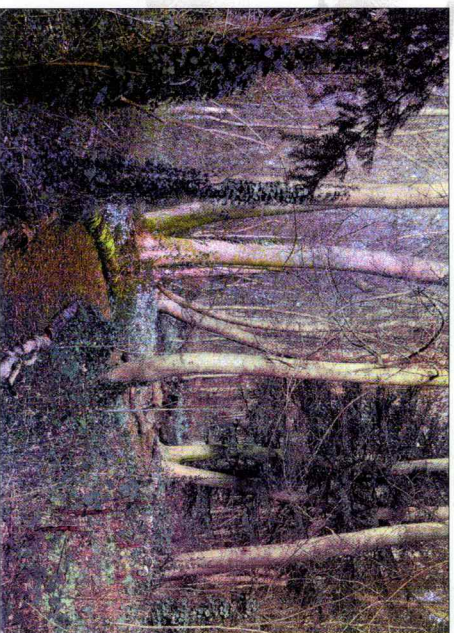
Ash, sycamore and lime.

Our Reserve is an important amenity for the area. Mankind has a long association with trees and open spaces and a need to have them close by but management is needed to ensure they are accessible and effective.



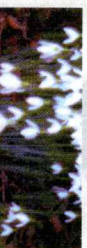
